Items from the CGSB Library collection can not be loaned. They are for use in the Library only.

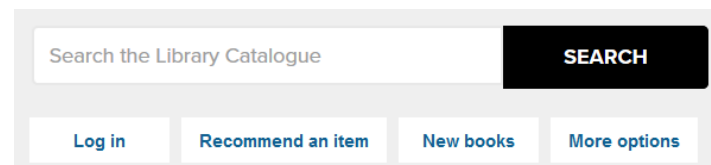
LIBRARY CARD

Your Curtin student ID card is also your library card. You will need it to swipe into the CGSB Library.

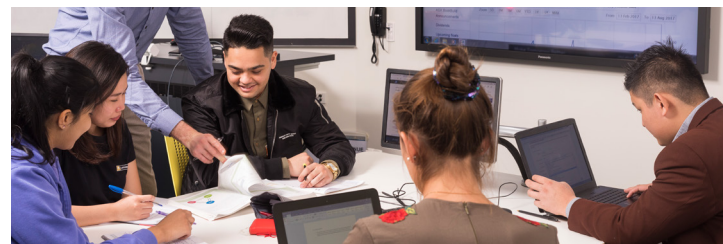


FINDING ITEMS

The Library catalogue is a useful resource for finding books, journal articles, exam papers and other materials for your research and study.



- Go to the Library catalogue at catalogue.curtin.edu.au or use the search box on the Library homepage (pictured).
- Log in.
- Search for your item. You can filter your search on the results page, by selecting the appropriate options on the right.
- Items available for loan are held at TL Robertson Library at the Bentley campus. Check the Library website at library.curtin.edu.au for opening hours.



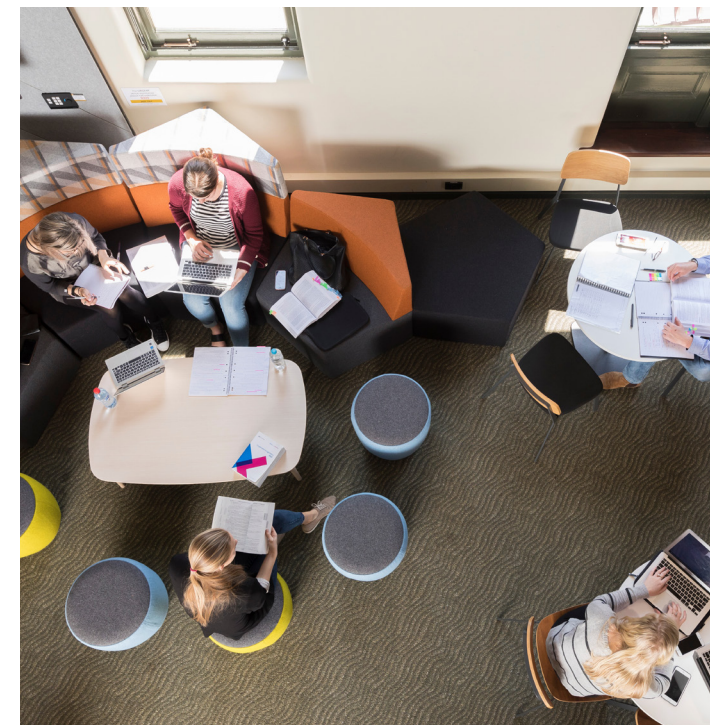
REQUIRED READINGS
