Predatory Publishing – What is it?

Confusing!

In 2019, 43 leading scholars, librarians, research funders and publishers from ten countries agreed on a definition of predatory publishing that would protect scholarship. It took 12 hours of discussion, 18 questions and 3 rounds to reach. <u>Nature, 11 December 2019</u>

"Put plainly, predatory journals are fake academic journals. Despite these breaches of good publication practices, their articles often appear in Google searches" <u>HealthyDebate blog,</u> July 20,2020.

Predatory Publishing and OA

Open Access (OA) models are designed to make research accessible to all

- This may involve paying Article Processing Fees (APCs)
- Still uses the most rigorous peer review and editing processes
- Funding agencies mandating that research be available for free
- Predatory Publishers are an unintended consequence of the OA model
 - Payment required
 - No quality checks
 - Quick turn around time


Predatory Publishing – the Risks

- Damage to the reputation of the researcher & institution
- No proper peer review is carried out to preserve the quality of the research output
- Researchers will most likely be unable to publish their article in other journals
- The publisher will retain the copyright to the article
- Candidacy may be compromised
- Loss of research or loss of trust in research
- Getting harder to distinguish legitimate journals from predatory journals

How Big is the Problem?

- A <u>study</u> suggests that predatory spam targeted at scholars cost universities \$1.1 billion annually. (January 2020)
- Analysis of Cabell's Predatory Reports indicates that 8.5% of all predatory Open Access journals are in the field of management. (September, 2019)
- More than <u>90 Checklists</u> exist to help identify predatory journals an overwhelming number for authors. (September, 2019)
- The US Federal Trade Commission won a US \$50 million court judgement against OMICS in 2019.

At least 25% of respondents have either published in a predatory journal, participated in a predatory conference, or don't know if they have.



If left unchallenged, the majority of respondents believe predatory practices will have detrimental effects.

The Predatory Landscape

- Hijacked journals Arctic & Arctic (Predatory Journal)
- <u>Cloned journals</u> example "<u>Current Science</u>" has 2 cloned journals
- Fraud Make up their own journal titles
- Present very professional websites (or sometimes not)
- Constantly evolving and changing
- Some publishers start out less credible and then raise standards MDPI
- Send unsolicited emails to get you to submit your research
- Some have a large number of titles in a variety of subjects
- Some have conferences associated with them

Note:

- Not all are based in developing countries
- Not all unprofessional looking websites are predatory
- It can be tough to distinguish a predatory journal from a journal that is under-resourced.


Fabio Caradonna Co-Editor



- Hard to distinguish titles from legitimate journals can sound similar
- Grammar and spelling in communications and web pages
- Email address (e.g. Gmail or different country from address)
- Fast turnover times
- Low cost publishing charges
- Board of Editors affiliations
- Impact Factors very creative

OMICS International is an example of a predatory publisher:

- The group started publishing in 2008 and by 2015, it claimed over 700 journals, although about half of them were defunct
- In 2016 OMICS became the first academic publisher to be sued by the U.S. Federal Trade Commission (FTC) for deceptive practices and the FTC was awarded a summary judgement of over US\$50 million
- It acquires legitimate publishers but does not continue with the quality
- Fake list of editors or uses names without consent of academics


Evaluation Tools

Before we start.....

- Not all lists agree on titles
- Some need a subscription
- Some can be biased
- Even Scopus has been fooled
- Some rely on information from publishers
- Legitimate publishers are being bought by predatory publishers

NO LIST TO RULE THEM ALL

Assessments of which journals are likely to be predatory or legitimate do not tally, and titles can appear in both categories. There is no way to know which journals were considered for a list but left off, or which were not considered.
