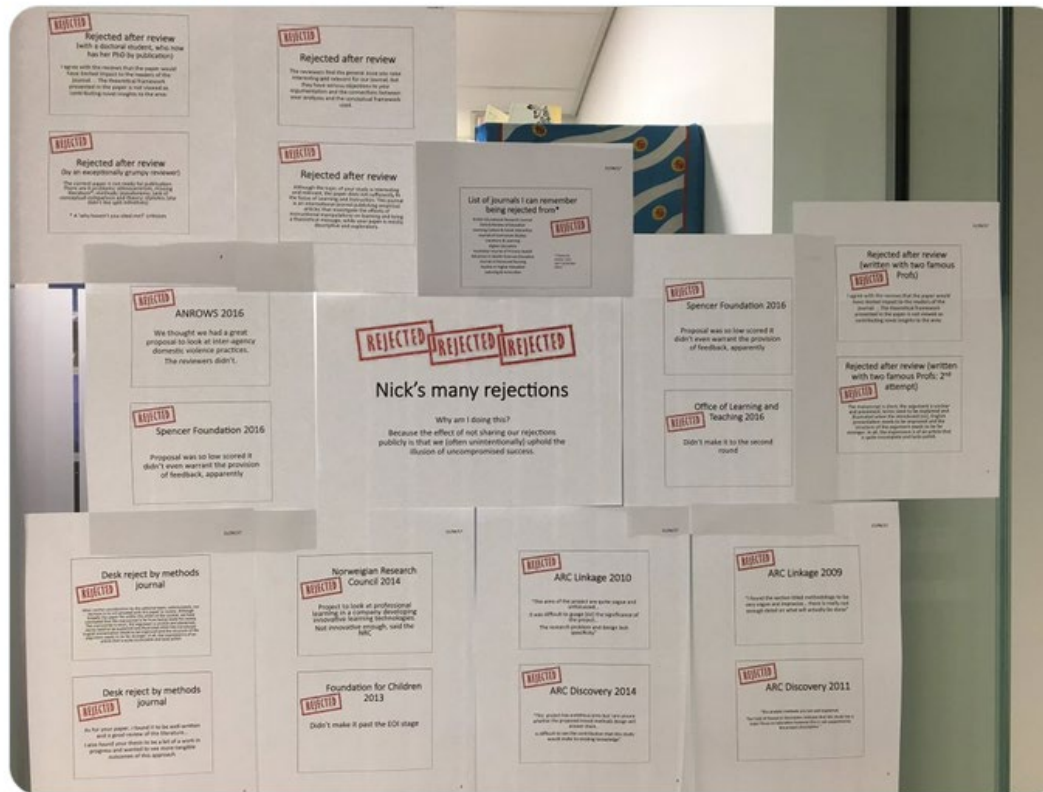
- ✓ Know the journal.

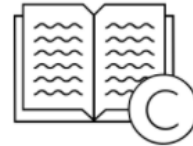

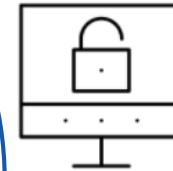
